Ziggy & Miles, guitar duo

Described as “Australian guitarist brothers making history” (*The Age*), Ziggy & Miles are among Australia’s finest young musicians forging an international career. Their performances are celebrated for their “deeply considered musicianship, immaculate care, and superlative technique” (*5MBS*). Winners of the 2023 YCA Susan Wadsworth International Auditions, the brothers are the first guitar duo in the organization’s history to receive this award.

Highlights of their upcoming 26-27 season include an extensive Australian tour alongside numerous U.S. recital presentations, including San Francisco Performances, the Buffalo Chamber Music Society, the Arizona Friends of Chamber Music, and the New York Guitar Festival. These recitals follow a series of successful recent appearances with Newport Classical, New York Classical Guitar Society, and Cultura Artística (Brazil), amongst others.

Their album *Sidekick* was named one of WQXR’s “Best New Classical Albums of 2023”. Praised by *Soundboard Magazine* for playing with “perfect unanimity”, the record showcases new commissions alongside their own arrangement of Debussy’s *Clair de Lune*.

Passionate about community engagement, the duo frequently partners with organizations like Project: Music Heals Us, and recently toured aged care and medical facilities across Victoria, Australia. From Melbourne, Australia, the brothers accumulated over 50 awards, including prizes from the Guitar Foundation of America, and the Adelaide international Guitar Festival.

Ziggy & Miles are graduates of The Juilliard School, where they were the first guitar duo accepted into the prestigious Artist Diploma program under the esteemed guitar pedagogue Sharon Isbin. They play guitars made by Jim Redgate and use Savarez Strings.
